The judging panel has also expanded to include former JUSTYS Case of the Year winners and select digital forensics and investigative experts, bringing outside perspective and deeper technical scrutiny to every nomination.

The Case of the Year award now has four categories, including Crimes Against Children & Human Trafficking, Narcotics, Major Crimes and Protecting Nations. In addition, the JUSTYS recognize excellence across the digital forensics and investigations community. Every category below is judged to the same demanding standard and only nominations that demonstrate clear, measurable impact rise to the top:
